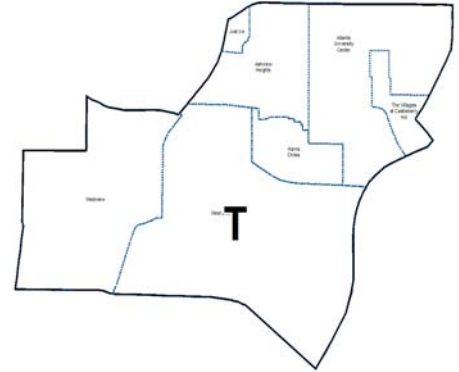

AN ORDINANCE

BY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT/HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE TO RE-ORGANIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, OFFICE OF CODE COMPLIANCE, INTO THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO AMEND VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE ATLANTA CITY CODE TO ACHIEVE THIS RE-ORGANIZATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Office of Code Compliance is organizationally structured under the Department of Planning and Community Development; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public health, safety and welfare to re-organize the Office of Code Compliance into the Atlanta Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the re-organization will allow the Office of Code Compliance to avail itself of the expertise and resources of the Atlanta Police Department in the administration and enforcement of its duties and functions.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1: Atlanta City Code Sec. 2-239 which reads as follows:

Sec. 2-239. - Bureaus in the department of planning and community development.

The department of planning and community development shall consist of the following bureaus:

- (1) Bureau of buildings;
- (2) Bureau of planning;
- (3) Bureau of economic development;
- (4) Bureau of housing;
- (5) Bureau of code compliance.

Shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-239. - Offices in the department of planning and community development.

The department of planning and community development shall consist of the following offices:

- (1) Office of buildings;
- (2) Office of planning;
- (3) Office of housing;

Section 2: Atlanta City Code Sec. 2-243.1 which outlines the functions and duties of the bureau of code compliance within the Department of Planning and Community Development is hereby *repealed*.

Section 3: Atlanta City Code Sec. 98-53 which is currently reserved shall hereafter read as follows:

Sec. 98-53. - Office of Code Compliance.

- (a) The department of police shall contain the office of code compliance.
- (b) The functions and duties of the office of code compliance shall include:
 - (1) Administration and enforcement of The Atlanta Housing Code;
 - (2) Administration and enforcement of The Atlanta Commercial, Institutional, and Industrial Building Maintenance Code;
 - (3) Administration and enforcement of housing demolition and in rem activities.
